

Should Roberts Creek Become a Village?

An Ad Hoc Committee has been formed from a broad cross section of Roberts Creek residents to attempt to address the concerns already expressed at two separate RC Town Hall meetings.

The primary purpose of the *Roberts Creek Research Committee on Incorporation (RCRCI)* is to determine if the community of RC is interested in pursuing a different form of governance.

Some of the questions currently under consideration include:

- Are we in danger of being annexed (absorbed) by Gibsons or Sechelt?
- How can we preserve the values of the Creek?
- How do we maintain our rural character, keep control of our neighbourhood and foster thoughtful development?
- Should we do nothing?
- What would the ramifications of incorporating as a village be?
- Will it cost us more money?
- Should we join either Gibsons or Sechelt?
- Is there an alternative governance structure that is better than a municipality?
